COMMITMENT AND ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT

In its activity, GECI maintains the commitment to minimize and control the potential impacts that GECI can generate on the environment. The Environmental Policy of the Company defines the principles of action for the improvement of environmental sustainability and involves all employees in this common goal.

In order to promote the correct environmental management, GECI is governed by the principles of the international standard ISO 14001.

The Management Manual allows unifying and coordinating the environmental management of the company in a global way. It is the reference document and is made according to the ISO 14001 standard.

Identification and compliance with applicable environmental legislation, identification of environmental aspects relevant to the activity from a life-cycle perspective, identification of stakeholders and their requirements, and the development of management prevention measures, are fundamental elements of the system.

In this sense, GECI has specific procedures for the identification of environmental aspects. In the initial phases of the projects, the feasibility of applying the available eco-efficiency measures is studied, as well as the proposal of the same to the clients, with the aim of preventing and minimizing the possible associated impacts.

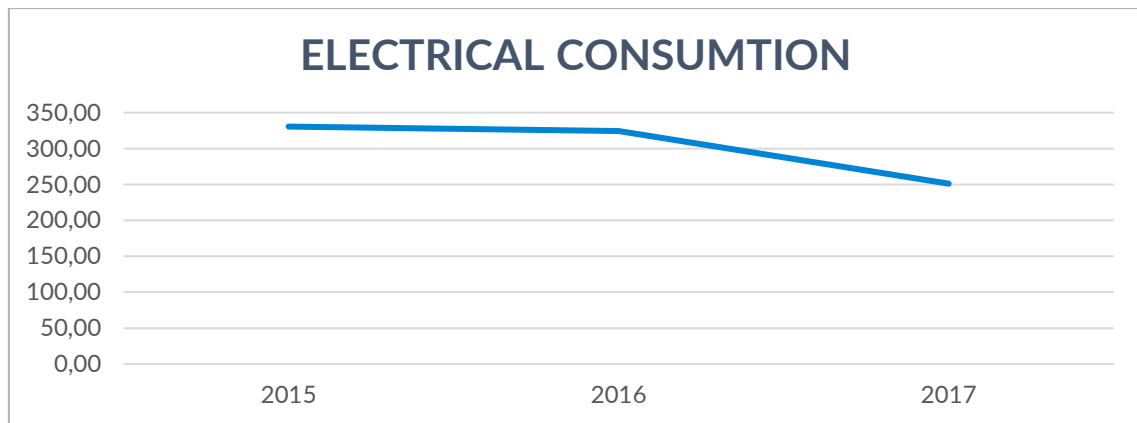
GECI takes into account supplier environmental initiatives, such as ISO 14001 certification, and requests this information at the time of its approval. This criterion, for example, applies to carriers.

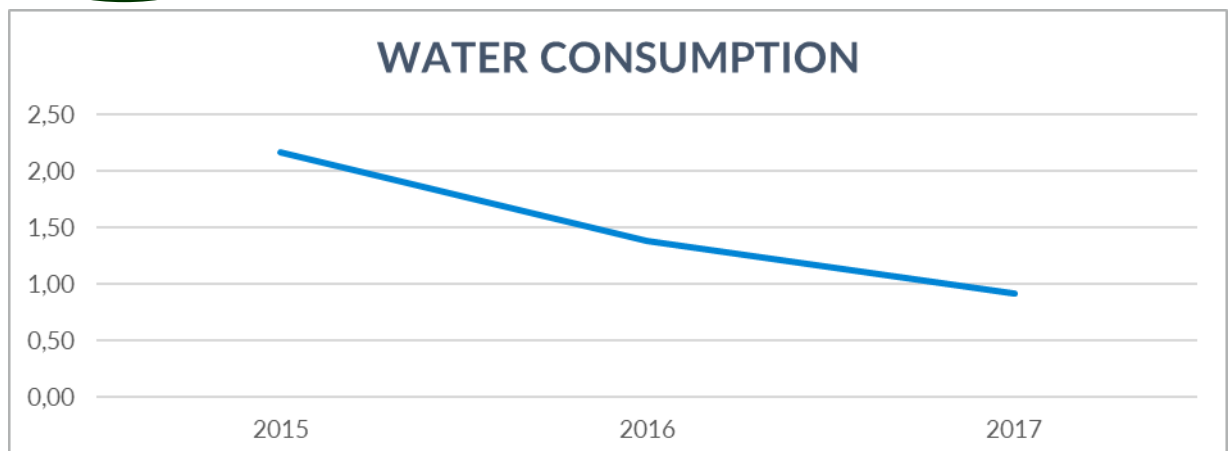
GECI annually establishes an environmental program that identifies environmental objectives and indicators.
